The symposium is open to graduating undergraduates from all Chicago-area schools. Students interested in participating should send their name, school, brief author bio, and proposal in .doc/.docx format in an email to iahsymposium@gmail.com. The proposal document should contain an abstract of 200-250 words as well as an essay of roughly 6-8 pages with necessary figures/images. The title of the proposal document should be the name of your essay (ex. "Art and Objecthood.doc"). Presentations will last no more than 10-15 minutes. Please do NOT include your name, school, or author bio in your proposal document as it will ease the blind review process. Only include this information in the email.
